DESCRIPTION

Judges, prosecutors and court staff will be able to analyse the right to health protection, the legal effects of its provision as a fundamental right and as a human right, and the state duties that such provision demands.

The one-and-a-half face-to-face training consists of providing a general overview of the European legal framework as well as the ECHR and CJEU jurisprudence.

Expert speakers will focus on aspects such as health and healthcare in the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union, the Right to healthcare and the European Court of Human Rights jurisprudence, the principle of

Effectiveness and Complementarity between health and Consumer Protection, Health Data and their regime under GDPR, Health and non-discrimination on the basis of illness, obesity, temporary incapacity, Conflict between health and other fundamental rights.

Practitioners will be able to exchange knowledge and best practices among experts and peers across the EU by applying the European legal framework and jurisprudence in practical cases.
